During discussion at our last meeting it is obvious that we lay down some directional guidelines in respect to our meeting proceedure.

Firstly a preview- as President I have endeavoured to conduct meetings under the general rules of debate, minutes taken & a system introduced covering correspondence, newsletter, finance etc, also to promote public interest in the Old Gaffers' Association, our association with the Maritime Museum & our Yacht Clubs which has led to participation & involvment in events such as Tall Ships, First Fleet, Slopje Replica, from which many favourable letters & comments were received.

Mention of a constitution was made, this is impossible as it involves legal advise, & costwisw not to be considered.

Articles of association as above to a lesser degree.

Rules would suffice for our small association & I offer the following-

- 1. Meeting conducted under Rules of Debate motions moved seconded, members to speak for & against & votes taken.
- 2. Any matter which may be contentious or affect the O.G.A. or members require a notice of motion of 14 days before the meeting, or easier, notice placed at a meeting & to be dealt with at the following meeting this would ensure that all members would be advised of details before it becomes a fait accomplie & further those who cannot attend often through other commitments will be up to date on club matters which is their right.
- 3. A Quorum be established this is necessary otherwise a very small group could make decisions which may not please, will obviate any loading of meetings, quorum of 10, at present we have 26 financial members.
- 4. Voting-only financial members can vote. Visitors cannot vote or discuss matters under motion.
- 5. Visitors are welcome to our meetings.

Simple rules as above will ensure smooth approach to conducting the meeting & will overcome any confusion which may arise as whether we are an Association, Club, Society or whatever.
