Suggested Racing Rules.

There shall be 3 trophies as follows:-

O.G.A. CHAMPION. Open to all yachts. Straight out race with no handicaps. The winner of this trophy shall not be eligible for either of the other trophies.

"A" FLEET TROPHY. Open to all yachts with a T.C.F. of 7000 or higher. (On present handicaps these would be Nell, Roamarick, Moondance, Leprena & Warroo.)

"B" FLEET TROPHY. Open to all remaining yachts.
"A" & "B" Trophies will be allocated to the yacht in each fleet which scores the highest total points over all O.G.A. races during the season. Points shall be allocated as follows:- lst. 30 pts. 2nd. 29 & reducing by 1 point for each place thereafter.

THE CHAMPIONSHIP RACE will be held annually as near possible to March 31. Other races shall be held (Preferably 2 per season) on dates to suit the host Club.

GENERAL. SPINNAKERS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED IN ANY RACE.

Headsails may be poled out, & working sails (Headsails, Topsails or Mainsails or Mizzens may be changed, lowered or set during a race. Please consider these suggestions & let Doug Rickman know Sunday as it could be desirable to apply the Trophy allocations to the season just finishing.
